



Exhibitor Health Permit Requirements

- If the vendor or convenience store carries a license through the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets (most likely a 20C license) and they are giving away samples of a food product that does not require refrigeration or hot holding (examples: chips or cookies), then they **DO NOT** need a temporary permit.
- If the vendor is giving away food samples that require refrigeration or heating/hot holding (examples: milk or yogurt) then they **DO** need a temporary permit.
- If the vendor is going to be doing any food preparation at the event then they **DO** need a permit (examples: mixing or blending food items, cooking items, etc.)
- If the vendor does not have any license through NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets then they **DO** need a temporary permit
